

ON-LINE APPLICATION PROCESS

Welcome to the On-line Grant Management System (GAMS).

GAMS is designed to be user friendly and provide the applicant and the Homeland Security Advisory Committee (HSAC) the best possible information for application of funds.

GAMS should be used for the funding requests through:

- State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) or
- Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI)

During this process, your application may be saved. You may return at a later time to continue filling out your application, if needed. Record the Application Number prior to exiting the system to facilitate later access of the application prior to submission.

TROUBLE SHOOTING REMINDERS

- ❖ Prior to submitting an application, the applicant must establish communication with a **Homeland Security Advisory Committee representative to sponsor** their application. The application sponsor is the HSAC representative that can help you with questions, obtain information and help facilitate the application process when it reaches the review and approval process. Select a sponsor by choosing a discipline they represent. All contact information for the sponsor is included on this site. You will be asked to provide the name of the sponsor during the application process. A detailed listing of Homeland Security Advisory Committee members by discipline is available on the on-line application website.
- ❖ If purchasing equipment, applicants will be required to submit a quote(s) for the desired equipment and provide the related Authorized Equipment List (AEL) category number below. Quotes may be uploaded electronically or submitted with the hard copy of the application. It is recommended the applicant do both. **Note:** A comprehensive listing of allowable equipment categories and types can be found on the web-based AEL **Responder Knowledge Base (RKB) website**.

Example: Equipment Item: Armor, Body

Quoted Cost: \$5,000

AEL: 01LE-01-ARMR
