




**Franklin County

FCDJFS is stepping up its voter registration efforts to assist Franklin County citizens in registering to vote or update their existing Ohio voter registration as mandated by Ohio Revised Code 3503.10.

To assist in accomplishing this goal the following steps have been taken:

- ✓ Voter registration applications and assistance with the registration process will be provided to our customers at all of our Opportunity and Job Center locations.

- ✓ Site Employee Training is being provided for designated staff to ensure that employees at the agency comply with the requirements of the program.
