TRAINING OVERVIEW

Offenders continue to demonstrate antisocial behavior after their conviction and placement on supervision or programming. Managing this behavior is essential to the process of offender change and public safety. This session will look at the principles of reinforcement and sanctioning. These principles will be applied in various scenarios and practice opportunities. Participants will receive guidance on how to develop a behavior management system and how to implement it within both residential and non-residential settings. This will include options for establishing a quality assurance system to measure adherence to the system. Finally, the session will look at ODRC standards and strategies to meet these important guidelines.
