**RE:** **REQUEST FOR RESULTS FOR AN AOD RECOVERY COACH PROGRAM IN FRANKLIN COUNTY**

The Franklin County ADAMH Board of Trustees is seeking an agency to provide AOD recovery coaching services to ex-offenders recovering from substance use disorders residing in Franklin County.

Funds are to be used to provide at least one AOD Recovery Coach in an agency with demonstrated history in serving this population. Services should include:

- Introduction to and involvement in 12-step programming;
- Linkage with employment, volunteering or educational opportunities, housing, or other benefits;
- Development and planning of recovery-based social activities, some of which should include family participation; and
- Recovery support in the community.
