Caregiver Support Program



What is the Caregiver Support Program?

The Franklin County Office on Aging collaborates with the Central Ohio Area Agency on Aging (COAAA) to administer the Caregiver Support Program, which assists caregivers with a variety of free short-term services that can be accessed once a calendar year.

Program Services

- Adult day services
- Incontinent supplies
- Respite services
- Caregiver counseling
- Lift chairs
- Durable medical equipment
- Institutional respite
- And more!



Program Eligibility

Franklin County residents are eligible for these services if they meet one of the following eligibility requirements:

- Are a non-paid caregiver for an adult aged 60 or older*
- Are a non-paid parent or relative aged 55 or older caring for an adult child (ages 18-59) with disabilities*

(*Must demonstrate a need for in-home care assistance.)
