Are you an adult aged 55 or older caring for a minor child that's not your own?

What is the Kinship Support Program?

The Franklin County Office on Aging collaborates with the Central Ohio Area Agency on Aging (COAAA) to administer the Kinship Support Program, which assists kinship caregivers aged 55 and older who are providing full-time care to a minor child whose biological parents are unable to do so.

Program Services

Assistance is available once a calendar year and can include, but is not limited to:

- Appliances (Microwave, stove, dryer, etc.)
- Kinship caregiver counseling
- Infant/toddler/children supplies (Diapers, baby wipes, etc.)
- Mattress + box spring set / infant crib + mattress
