

# Maven Wallet makes getting financial support for family building easy

Maven Wallet is available at no cost to employees enrolled in the health plan to support you on your adoption, surrogacy, and/or fertility journey.

Maven Wallet is available for Franklin County Cooperative employees enrolled in the health plan. Eligible employees get access to a \$30,000 lifetime maximum per household to be utilized on eligible expenses across adoption and surrogacy journeys and a \$10,000 lifetime maximum per household to be utilized on eligible donor material expenses not otherwise covered by the health plan.



## Use Maven Wallet to cover costs like:

- Adoption agency fees
- Surrogacy agency fees
- Court & legal fees
- Donor materials for IUI/IVF

## Here is how to use Maven Wallet:

### 01 Learn more about your benefits

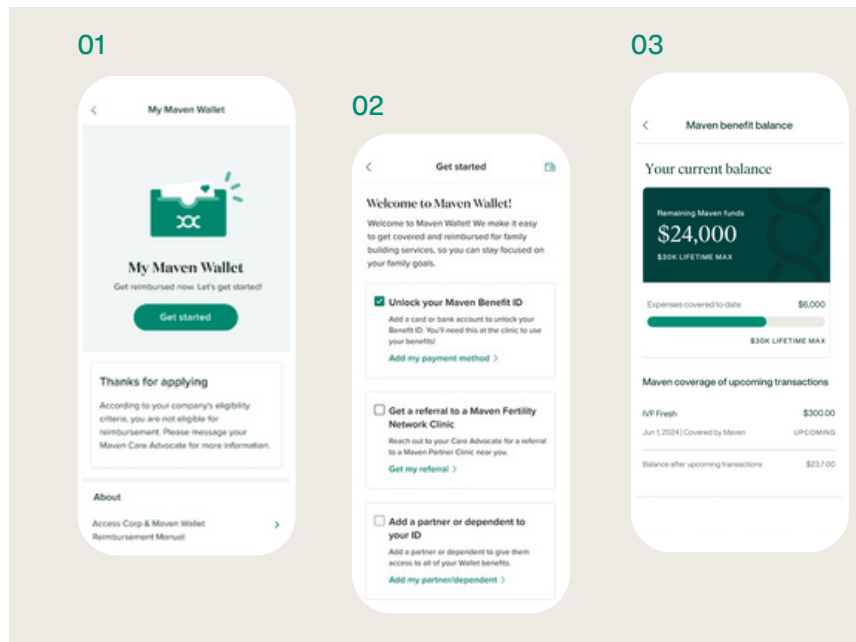
After activating your Maven account, employees can go to "Me" then "My Maven Wallet" in the app. Here you can read FAQs and learn more about eligible expenses. At anytime, you can also connect with your dedicated Care Advocate to learn more about your benefits.

### 02 Activate your Maven Wallet

Click on the "Apply for Maven Wallet" button to submit your application. It takes up to 1 business day to be approved. Once approved, you'll begin onboarding.

### 03 Get support and manage expenses

With Maven Wallet set up, you can start your family building journey with Maven's adoption, surrogacy, and fertility experts. In your Maven Wallet dashboard, you can check your balance and manage your expenses in real time—all in one place.
