MINUTES OF THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS

Monday, October 20, 2025

Commission convened at the Franklin County Judicial Services Building, Board of Commissioners Hearing Room, 369 South High Street, First Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215, on Monday, October 20, 2025, 1:30 p.m.

Chairman Baer opened the hearing. The first order of business was the roll call of the members and introduction of the staff and members of the Prosecutor's Office. The next order of business was approval of the minutes of the September 15, 2025, meeting. The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

NEW BUSINESS:

The next order of business was to hear Variance Application VA-4144. The owner/applicant of the gas station located at 3317 Cleveland Avenue is Yeong Jiang. The applicant is requesting a variance from Section 670.083(a) to reconstruct their convenience store with the increased minimum setback. The site is approximately 0.54 acres, zoned Community Service, with Smart Growth Overlay. The comprehensive plan for the area is the Clinton-Mifflin Land Use Plan. Staff recommended that upon approval the applicant will be required to:

No. 1: Apply for and receive approval of a certificate of Commercial Zoning Compliance from the Franklin County Planning Department prior to lot development (FCZR Sec. 705.02) No. 2: Apply for and receive approval of a building permit from the state. No. 3: Obtain any other required permits to comply with regulations. A motion was made by Chairman Baer, seconded by Mr. Martin, to admit the presentation, staff report, exhibits, and testimony from the applicant. The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

A motion was made by Ms. Hunter, seconded by Mr. Martin, to approve a variance from Section 670.083(a) of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution as outlined in the request for the applicant identified in Case No. VA-4144 with the three staff recommendations.

The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions. A motion was then made by Ms. Hunter, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the basis for approving the applicant's request for the variance from Section 670.0838 of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution as outlined in the request for the applicant identified in Case No. VA-4144 results from the applicant satisfying the criteria for granting a variance under Section 810.041(b). The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

The next order of business was to hear VA/CU-4146. The property owner was ARV Investors, LLC. The applicant was Paul Fatkins. The site is located at 1852 Little Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43223. It is a 0.15-acre property within Franklin Township, zoned Restricted Urban Residential, or R-8. The applicant and owner requested a conditional use for Section 312.031(a) of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution for a two-family dwelling in order to allow development of a two-family dwelling on the property.

The applicant and owner also requested variances from Sections 312.041, 312.042, and 312.043 of the Zoning Resolution to allow for a two-family dwelling that does not meet the required lot size, lot width, or side yard setbacks in an area zoned R-8. A motion was made by Chairman Baer, seconded by Ms. Hunter, to admit the presentation, staff report, exhibits, and testimony from the applicant. The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

A motion was made by Mr. Martin, seconded by Ms. Hunter, to approve a conditional use per Section 312.031(a) of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution as outlined in the request for the applicant identified in Case No. VA/CU-4146. The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

A motion was made by Mr. Martin, seconded by Ms. Hunter, that the basis for approving the applicant's request for the conditional use per Section 312.031(a) of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution, as outlined in the request for the applicant identified in Case No. VA/CU-4146, results from the applicant satisfying the criteria for granting a conditional use per Section 815.041. The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

A motion was made by Mr. Martin, seconded by Ms. Hunter, to approve a variance from Sections 312.041, 312.042, and 312.043 of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution as outlined in the request for the applicant identified in Case No. VA/CU-4146. The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

A motion was made by Mr. Martin, seconded by Ms. Hunter, that the basis for the approval of the applicant's request for the variance from Sections 312.041, 312.042, and 312.043 of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution, as outlined in the request for the applicant identified in Case No. VA/CU-4146, results from the applicant satisfying the criteria for granting a variance under Section 810.041(b). The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

The next order of business was to hear Variance Application 4151. The owner/applicant was Mohamud Jama, for a 0.12-acre property located in Mifflin Township in the Rural zoning district located at 2116 Myrtle Avenue. The applicant requested variances from Sections 110.041, 302.041(a), and 302.042 of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution to bring a nonconforming lot into conformity prior to the application for zoning compliance. staff believes that a practical difficulty inherently exists in the improper zoning of a property as Rural and recommended that the Board of Zoning Appeals approve variances from Sections 110.041, 302.041(a), and 302.042. A motion was made by Chairman Baer, seconded by Ms. Hunter, to admit the presentation, staff report, exhibits, and testimony from the applicant. The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

A motion was made by Ms. Hunter, seconded by Mr. Martin, to approve variances from Sections 110.041, 302.041(a), and 302.042 of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution as outlined in the request for the applicant identified in Case No. VA-4151. The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

A motion was made by Ms. Hunter, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the basis for approving the applicant's request for the variance from Sections 110.041 and 302.041(a) and 302.042 of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution, as outlined in the request for the applicant identified in Case No. VA-4151, results from the applicant satisfying the criteria for granting a variance under Section 810.041(b). The motion passed by a vote of three yeses, zero nos, and zero abstentions.

There being no further business coming before the Franklin County Board of Zoning Appeals, Chairman Baer adjourned the hearing.

II. Property Background/History

The property is located on the north side of Harrisburg London Road and on the west side of Harrisburg Georgesville Road. The northern half of the property is located in the Big Darby Creek Watershed Riparian Setback, with the entire principal structure being located in the Riparian Setback. The eastern portion of the property is also located in a FEMA identified floodway fringe that does not affect this request.

The following is a summary of the development and permit history of the parcel:

- 2008 House was constructed
- 2009 The Big Darby Creek Watershed Riparian Setback Established
 - o The existing principal structure fell into this setback.
- 2016 Current Property owners acquired property.
- 2025 Property owners applied for a Residential Zoning Compliance for a covered porch in the Riparian setback

IV. Comprehensive Plan

The Pleasant Township Comprehensive Plan (2009) recommends properties in the surrounding area be zoned as Rural (R). This property falls in a Tier 1 conservation area identified in the plan. The plan discourages development in or near any environmentally sensitive areas/near environmental features.

Franklin County Zoning Resolution Review

<u>Variance from Section 650.162(a) – List of Prohibited Uses: In the Riparian Setback:</u>

Construction. Construction of buildings or structures of any kind or size are prohibited. This restriction applies to new construction, and does not apply to existing residential structures and associated accessory structures.

The Applicant's proposal is to construct a 212 square foot covered deck on the eastern side of the house in the Big Darby Watershed Riparian Setback.

V. Technical Review Committee Agency Review

The case was referred to the Informal Technical Review Committee for comments on October 15th, 2025. FSWCD: Riparian setback mitigation would be for Zone 2 (25-100') @ 3 x 212 sf=636 or plant six (6) trees in lowest available zone.

VI. Area Variance Review Criteria

Section 810.041(b) – Area Variance:

The Board of Zoning Appeals shall only authorize a request for an area variance where the applicant demonstrates the existence of a practical difficulty in the use of the property. In determining whether a practical difficulty exists, the Board of Zoning Appeals shall consider and weigh the following factors, among others when appropriate, to determine if practical difficulties exist: *See application for Applicants full response*.

- 1) Whether the property in question will yield a reasonable return or whether there can be any beneficial use of the property without the variance;
 - a) Applicant's Response/Summary:
 "No, the only buildable area without the variance is at the front of the house, which would significantly alter the homes appearance and reduce curb appeal."
 - b) Staff's Response Staff believes that without the Variance the property can yield a reasonable return and be beneficially used as a residential property.
- 2) Whether the variance is substantial;
 - a) Applicant's Response/Summary: The applicant does not believe the Variance to be substantial.
 - b) Staff's Response Staff agrees with applicant and does not believe the Variance to be substantial.

- 3) Whether the essential character of the neighborhood would be substantially altered or adjoining properties would suffer a substantial detriment as a result of the variance;
 - a) Applicant's Response/Summary:

 The applicant believes that the proposed deck would be consistent with the character of the area.
 - b) Staff's Response

Staff aggress with the applicant and does not believe that the character of the neighborhood would be substantially altered as a result of the Variance.

- 4) Whether the variance would adversely affect the delivery of governmental services (e.g. water, sewer, garbage);
 - a) Applicant's Response/Summary:
 The applicants do not believe governmental services would be affected by the approval of this Variance.
 - b) Staff's Response Staff does not believe governmental services would be affected by the approval of this Variance.
- 5) Whether the property owner purchased the property with knowledge of the zoning restriction; See application for applicants' full response.
 - a) Applicant's Response/Summary: "The homeowners purchased the property without the knowledge of the zoning restrictions."
 - b) Staff's Response Staff does not know if the property owners knew of the zoning restrictions.
- 6) Whether the property owner's predicament feasibly can be obviated through some method other than a variance;
 - a) Applicant's Response/Summary:

 The applicant does not believe the property's owners predicament can be obviated through any other method than with the use of this variance.
 - b) Staff's Response

Staff does not believe the property owners predicament can be obviated through some other method without the approval of the Variance, as the entire principal structure falls within the Riparian setback.

- 7) Whether the spirit and intent of the zoning requirement would be observed and substantial justice done by granting the variance.
 - a) Applicant's Response/Summary: The applicant believes the spirt and intent would be observed, and a substantial justice will be granted by granting this variance.
 - b) Staff's Response:

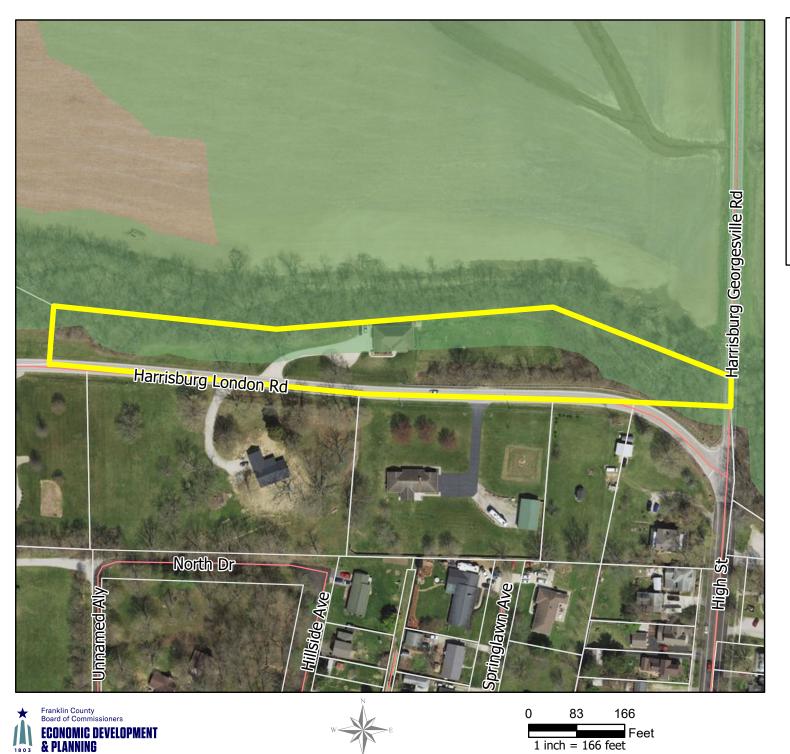
The Riparian Setback was established in 2009, a year after the construction of the existing house in 2008. With the proposed covered deck not being substantial, staff believes a substantial justice will be granted, and the spirt and intent of the zoning requirements will be observed.

VII. Recommendation:

Staff believes a practical difficulty exists on the property. If the Riparian setback was established prior to the construction of the house, or the house was constructed after the setback was established, said house may have been constructed outside the Riparian Setback and the proposed covered deck could be allowed. Since the entirety of the principal structure is located in the Riparian setback, any additions to the structure would require the approval of variances.

Based on Staff's Analysis, staff's recommendation is that the Board of Zoning Appeals **approve** a Variance from Section 650.162(a) of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution to construct a covered deck located in the Big Darby Creek Riparian Setback in an area zoned Rural (R).

Site Plan Requirements

- The site plan must be prepared by a design professional (i.e. registered surveyor, engineer and/or architect) and include all items required under Sections 705.022 and 810.022 of the Franklin County Zoning Resolution
 - Site plans which are incomplete and/or not drawn to scale will not be accepted.
- Two (2) copies minimum size of 8.5"x11" paper, maximum size of 11"x17" paper *Larger size copies are acceptable in addition to the min./max. sizes required
- North arrow and appropriate scale (i.e. 1 inch = 20 feet)
- Property lines, with the exact dimensions of the lot labeled
- Street right-of-way boundaries including street centerline
- The exact dimensions and location of all <u>existing</u> buildings (principal and accessory), structures (decks, patios, pools, paved parking areas, courtyards, etc.) and driveways/access points, indicating setbacks of each from property lines with measurements/distances labeled
- The exact dimensions, height and location of all <u>proposed</u> buildings, structures, additions, or modifications to the property, indicating setbacks from property lines with measurements/distances labeled
- Landscaping details provide the quantity, location, size and plant species (Ohio Native Non-Invasive Only) used
- All open space areas including calculatons (percentage) of impervious vs. pervious surface

- Parking layout with required parking calculations provided

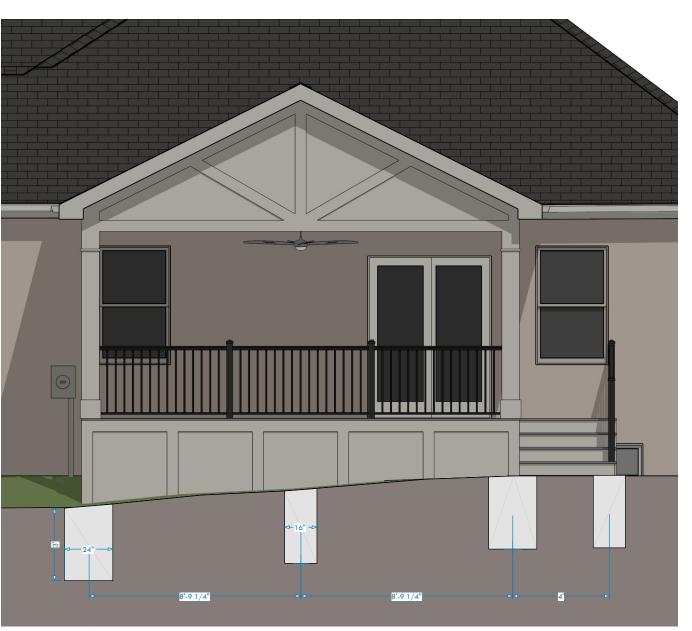

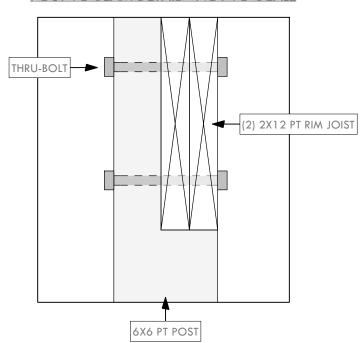
LEDGER BOARD DETAIL - NOT TO SCALE

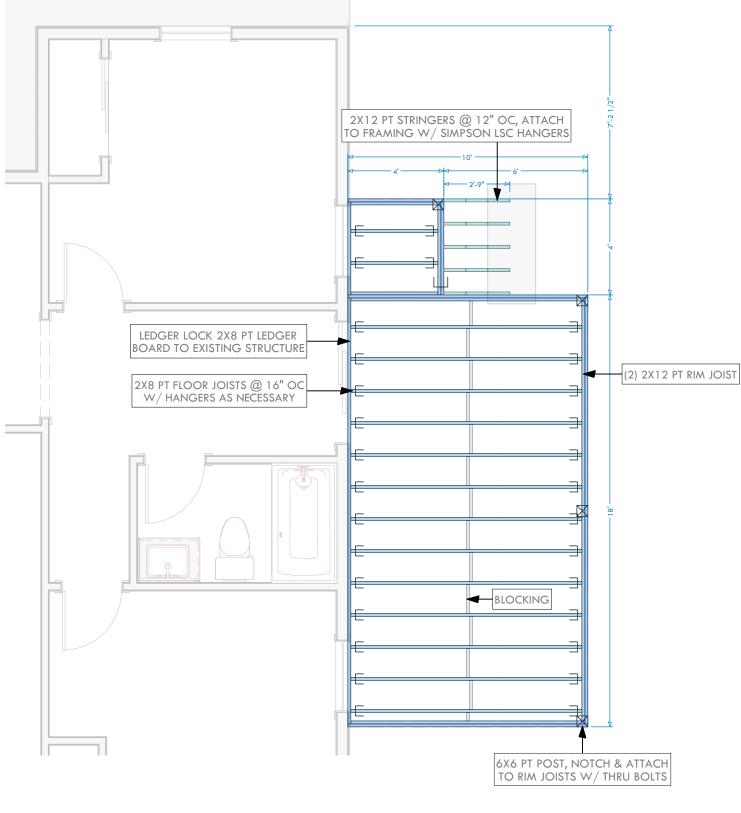


STAIR DETAIL - NOT TO SCALE

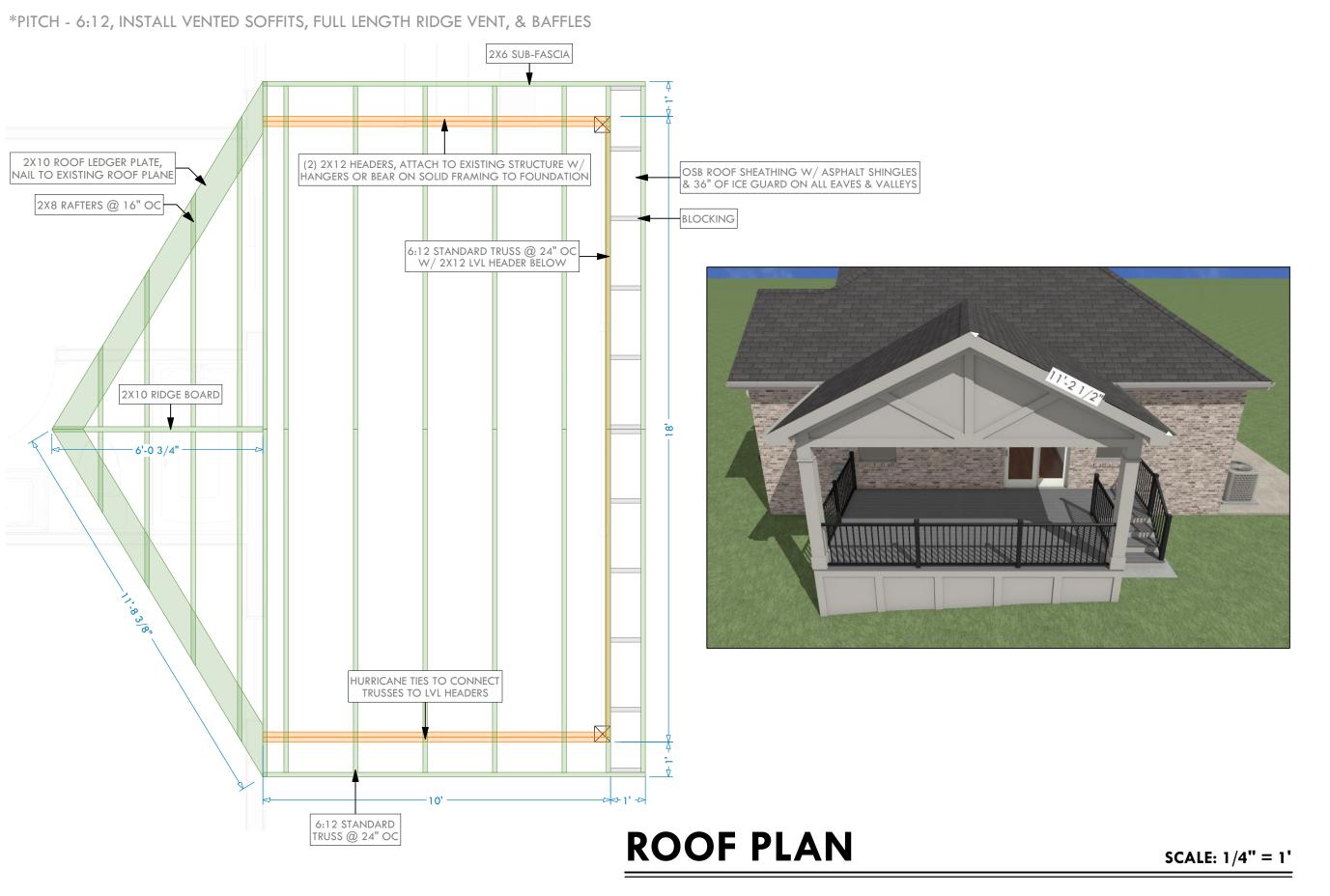

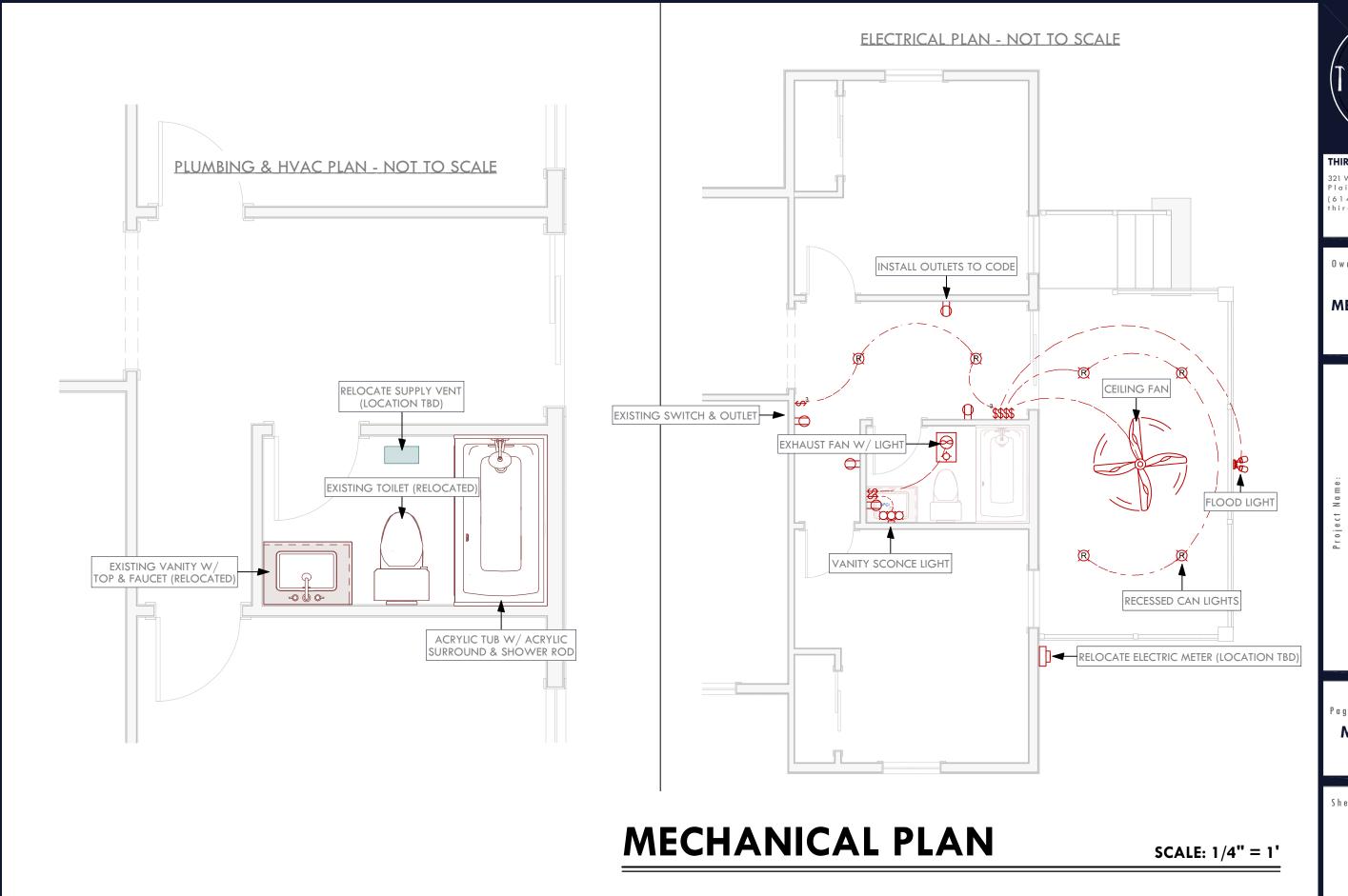
