## **Purpose**

Produce a stream setback zoning overlay district for incorporation in the Franklin County Zoning Resolution.

The Ohio EPA, in its recently approved water quality plan, requires local governments to adopt stream setbacks for the Franklin County portion of the Big Darby Watershed. That plan spells out specific requirements for these setbacks.

This project will produce a regulation tailored to the Franklin County Zoning Resolution that incorporates all the Ohio EPA requirements for the setbacks.

# Scope

The project will adapt a model stream setback regulation for inclusion in the Franklin County Zoning Resolution. The regulation will fully comply with Ohio EPA requirements as listed in the 208 Plan.

The project supports the Big Darby Accord by implementing the recommended riparian corridor protections.
