

Trudy Bartley Associate Vice President Office of Government Affairs

Trudy Bartley served as the executive director of Partners Achieving Community Transformation (PACT), an independent nonprofit organization dedicated to the comprehensive redevelopment of the Near East Side neighborhood of Columbus, and as an Associate Vice President in the Office of Government Affairs at The Ohio State University. In her capacity at PACT, Trudy is responsible for spearheading the strategic implementation of the Blueprint for Community Investment, a detailed master plan focused on revitalizing the Near East Side. At Ohio State, she is responsible for local government affairs as well as economic and community development projects and special initiatives involving the university.

Prior to coming to Ohio State, Trudy worked in the Ohio Department of Development. Throughout her tenure with the department, she served in three positions: Chief Operating Officer, Interim Director of the Minority Business Enterprise Division, and Federal Stimulus Coordinator. Previously, she was President of Diversified Development Group, a minority real estate development company and worked as deputy director for the City of Columbus for 11 years.

Today, Bartley serves as the Chair of the Board of Trustees for the Central Ohio Transit Authority, and is on the boards of the United Way, ADAMH and the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission.
