POSITION TITLE: Deputy Dog Warden (Bargaining Unit) **PCN:** 072014

RESPONSIBILITIES: Receive and respond to service requests. Investigate complaints of stray and/or aggressive dogs. Investigate reports of sick or injured dogs and conduct preliminary assessment. Impound/transport sick and injured dogs to Animal Shelter, if necessary. Impound and transport dogs, cats, raccoons, bats or other animals when rabies exposure is suspected. Prepare and issue citations and criminal complaints to dog owners for violation of ORC Chapter 955. Take reports of livestock loss. Set and retrieve animal traps.

Patrol assigned area to check for loose dogs and other violations of ORC Chapter 955. Assist law enforcement agencies when warrants are served regarding ORC Chapter 955 violations. Capture wildlife at the request of the County Health Department.

Prepare quarantine reports for the County Health Department. Represent the County as a prosecution witness, when necessary. Clean and disinfect assigned vehicle daily. Represent the department at public relations events. Function as Radio Dispatcher in back-up capacity.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: High school diploma or GED with two (2) years previous animal handling experience or any equivalent combination of training and experience. A valid Ohio Driver's license is required.

STARTING SALARY: \$15.09/hr., plus a 55-cent shift differential for second shift or a 60-cent shift differential for third shift. A comprehensive benefits package is offered with this position.
