


Is Your Home Energy Service Disconnected? Do You Need Help With Your Utility Bills?

Super Saturday Service Gives You Options!

What is Super Saturday?

Super Saturday is a customer-focused event to provide additional access to the Home Energy Assistance Program/Winter Crisis Program (HEAP/WCP). IMPACT's HEAP/WCP helps low-income families in Columbus and Franklin County who are at or below 200% of the federal poverty guideline with a one-time payment of up to \$175 toward their bill. The payment will be made if the service is in threat of disconnection, the service is off, or if the service is being transferred.



When are Super Saturdays?

Up to 65 customers will be seen on a first come, first-served basis. Customers must bring the following information with them to the *Super Saturday* event:

1. Valid, government-issued photo identification (i.e., a driver's license)
2. Social Security cards for everyone in the household or print out
3. Proof of income for the past 90 days for everyone in the household age 18 and older
4. Current gas and/or electric bills
5. A copy of the lease, if the service is currently disconnected
